# PREPARING FOR YOUR VASECTOMY



#### Your appointment will require:

- 15-30 minute consultation, after pre-consult video viewed from patient portal
- 25-30 minutes procedure
- 15-20 minutes recovery

## **PRE-OPERATIVE**

- If you are having your vasectomy at Miami Private Hospital under general anaesthetic, please remain nil by mouth (includes all food and fluids) for 6 hours prior to the procedure and arrange a carer to collect you from the hospital postsurgery and stay with you for the first 24 hours. If you are having your vasectomy as an outpatient in our clinic, please don't fast.
- 2 Stop ALL vitamin supplements 14 days prior to the procedure, if possible. This includes vitamin E, multi vitamins, fish oil, garlic, ginko biloba and ginger.
- 3 Avoid taking aspirin or anti-inflammatory tablets (voltaren or nurofen) 7 days before the procedure discuss this with your GP or Doctor if you are required to take these regularly.
- 4 SHAVE all hair off the front groin area all of scrotum & one handbreadth above penis (refer diagram to the left).
  - Use scissors or clippers first then use a razor.
- 5 1 hour before your appointment take 2 paracetamol/panadol tablets with a sip of water. Have more available for after the procedure.
- 6 Shower just before leaving home and ensure that your bladder is empty before going into your procedure appointment.
- 7 Wear 2 pairs of firm fitting cotton underpants (jockeys) under loose clothes and easy to slip on and off footwear to your procedure. No boxer shorts.
- 8 Signatures are required for your informed consent.

# **POST-OPERATIVE**

**DRIVING:** If you wish to drive on the day of your vasectomy you can only have a local anaesthetic. If you have additional sedating drugs, or you're having your vasectomy at Miami Private Hospital, you cannot drive for 24 hours following your procedure.

### 2 **MOVEMENT:** Lie or sit for the first 4-24 hours. Rest for at least 24 hours.

- Avoid the risk of fainting by getting up slowly and sit, rather than stand at the toilet
- No heavy lifting, climbing, swimming, cycling or exercise for 7-10 days.
- **3 ICE PACKS:** Ice the area intermittently for the first 12-24 hours after the procedure, using a cold pack that consist of a bag of frozen peas or a soft gel ice pack.
  - Keep two pairs of jockey underpants on and place the cold pack between them
  - A cold pack will be provided after the procedure
  - Have bags of peas or soft gel ice packs in your freezer at home
  - Wrap the cold pack in a tea towel to avoid frostbite
  - Change cold packs regularly as they thaw out
  - Keep a cold pack on overnight no need to wake up and change the pack through the night
  - Remove cold pack in the morning
  - Wear firm fitting cotton underwear day and night for 7-10 days.
- **PAIN RELIEF:** Use Panadol (paracetamol) or Panadeine.
  - Use Nurofen or Voltaren Rapid if further pain relief is required, especially for the dull ache that may occur 1-2 weeks post procedure.
- 5 **DRESSING:** Do not shower until the following day after your procedure. Do not bathe while the dressing is in place
  - Shower using mild soap on the area
  - The dressing is to be removed 5 days after the procedure in the morning before your shower If it falls off earlier this is not a concern. Apply some antiseptic and a band aid
  - Expect a small open wound, which will heal and is not a concern
  - Immediately notify Dr Lekich on 0412 584 231 if the wound is:
    - » Gaping open
    - » Discharging or evidence of pus
    - » Inflamed or red
    - » Sudden increase in pain or swelling
    - » If you experience pain on urinating or blood in the urine.
- 6 SEX & SPERM TEST: No sex for the first 5 days. After that PROTECTED sex only.
  - After the dressing is removed, have as much PROTECTED sex as possible until you have done your 12 week sperm test and have received final clearance from us
  - You will need to do a sperm test 12 weeks after the procedure
  - There needs to be not more than 1 hour between when you do the test to when it is analysed in the lab
  - Contact the lab closest to you on the back of the request slip a few days prior to organise the test
  - There is an out of pocket cost for this test, depending on your pathology provider
  - We generally receive test results around 7-10 days later and we will notify you of these results.
- **7 CONTRACEPTION:** Use contraception until notified that your test result is clear.
- 8 **KEEP US UPDATED:** Text your doctor after you have removed your dressing and advise that you are happy with your progress <sup>©</sup> If you have any minor concerns or questions feel free to text your doctor directly.

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
